- 2 Scraper

## 1 Gather Supplies & Personal Protective Equipment



Gather Supplies and Apply Personal Protective Equipment Gather necessary cleaning supplies as directed. Materials may include bone scraper, gum removal spray, brush, and vacuum

Anytime you clean with chemicals, make sure you use personal protective equipment, as directed on the Safety Data Sheets for the products being used.

## 2 Use Scraper



Use a scraper to remove as much of the gum as possible.

## 3 Spray with Spartan Chewing Gum Remover



Point nozzle at 45° angle. Using short, quick bursts, spray until gummy substance is frozen solid.

## 4 Residue Cleaning



Chip or scrape off frozen matter using a putty knife, dull knife or scraper.

## 5 Vacuum



Vacuum all particles off floor. Return supplies when complete.
